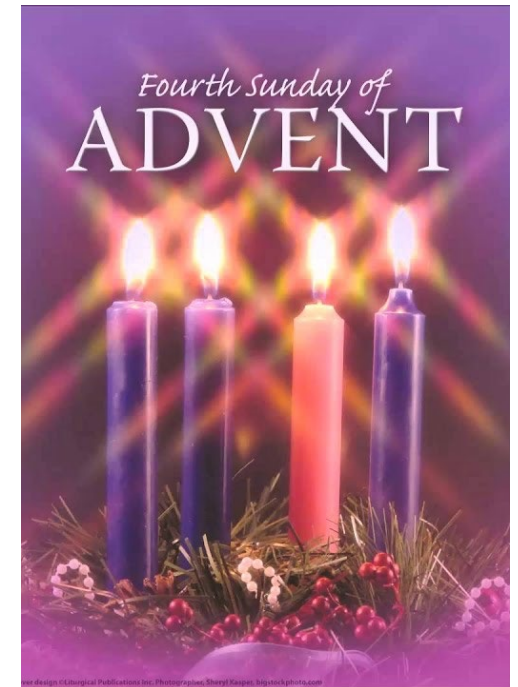

DINNER FOR EIGHT: Have you ever looked around the church and said to yourself, "I wish I knew more of these people that I see every Sunday morning"? Here's how it works: Through the month of December we will be taking sign-ups on the list provided in the fellowship hall, and all who sign up will be assigned by random choice to a group of eight people (singles or couples), all of whom agree to help host one dinner during the January through June season.
