ANNOUNCEMENTS

A WARRANT HAS BEEN POSTED FOR A MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION to take place on Sunday, June 25th, following the morning worship service, for the purpose of voting on whether to include the following article in our Constitution. This is a federal government requirement for all non-profit organizations to be officially recognized as 501(C)(3). While all churches are assumed to be a 501(C)(3), to be officially recognized requires the dissolution article. Requesting official recognition would enable us to qualify for discounted or donated software services such as QuickBooks. This would be a savings of about \$1000 a year:

Article IX Dissolution of the Organization
Upon the dissolution of this Organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code or shall be distributed to the Federal Government or to a state or local government for public purposes.
