that we may present everyone perfect in Christ.

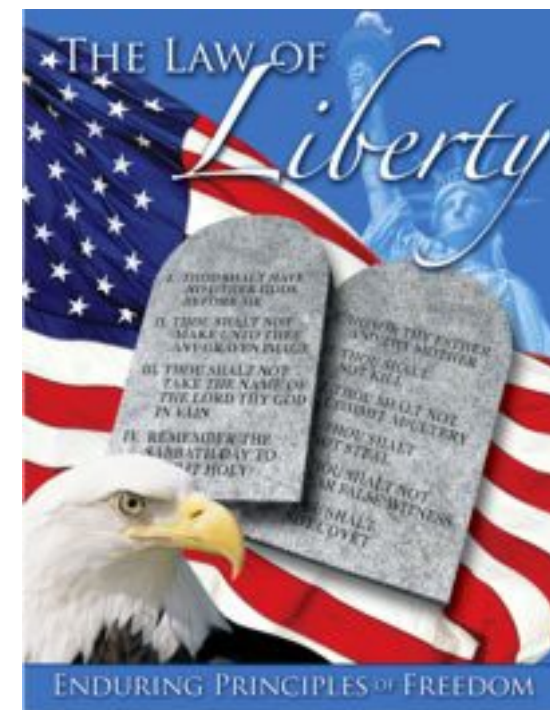
## ALWAYS HAS, ALWAYS WILL
