that we may present everyone perfect in Christ.

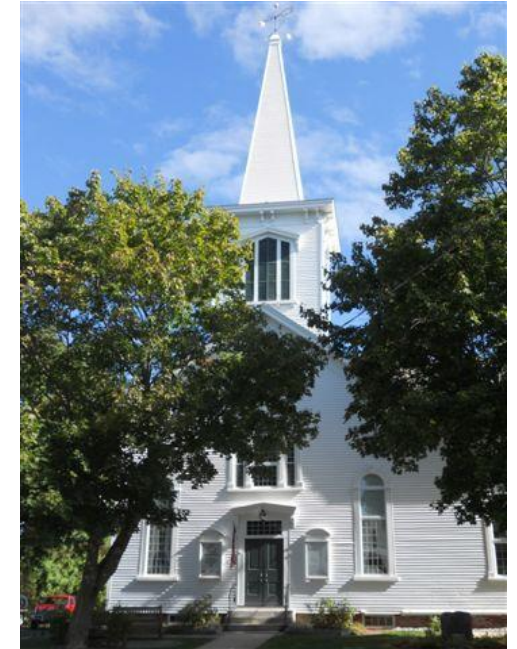
ALWAYS HAS, ALWAYS WILL
