"TO TELL THE TRUTH"
(John 4:4-42)

We live in a time when there are more shades of "gray" than ever before, so, how do we know what *real truth* is? Well, Jesus said, "I am the truth!" Ergo, the best way to know if our lives are truthful or not is to compare them to Jesus's. So today, let's look at four truths that will help us do just that.

TRUTH #1: I CAN'T HIDE FROM MY PAST! (What you run from, you run into.)

- Ignore sin
- Sheer determination
- Give in to sin

TRUTH #2: JESUS KNOWS ALL ABOUT ME AND STILL LOVES ME!
