"Helpless and Hopeless NO MORE"

(Romans 5:1-8) (Pew Bible Page 789)

Many people often feel Helpless and hopeless with life or with many things' life throws at them. Hopefully, together, we'll see why that doesn't need to be so, if only we'll seek god first. For when we seek God; He gives us:

PEACE

ACCESS

HOPE

SEVEN MARKERS TO SEE IF YOUR HOPE IS TOWARDS GLORY (ETERNAL) INSTEAD OF THE HERE-AND-NOW (TEMPORAL):

- 1. First is the desire to be holy, rather than happy.
- 2. Secondly, a person may be considered spiritually mature when he wants to see the honor God advance through his life, even if it means he experiences dishonor and loss.
- 3. Thirdly, the spiritually mature person wants to carry
- 4. Fourthly, a Christian is spiritually mature when he sees life from God's perspective.
- 5. Fifthly, another desire of the spiritually mature person is to die right rather than live wrong.
- 6. Sixth, is to see others advance at your own expense.
- 7. Seventh, is spiritually mature person makes <u>etemity</u> <u>judgements instead of time judgements</u>. (that is, you base the decisions you make every day on how this is gonna impact eternity, not how it's gonna impact your day.)
